Minimum Insulation Requirements and Available Energy Rebate Programs May 24, 2017

Subject: Minimum Insulation Requirements and Available Energy Rebate Programs

With the increased adoption of IBC/IECC 2015, there have been several changes to the minimum R-value requirements in commercial roofing. Minimum insulation R-value requirements will provide guidance on each state's current minimum R-value requirements. Energy incentive programs will provide information on incentives that may be available when a building's energy efficiency is increased. In addition, TrueRoof Cost is an excellent tool for showing the benefits of higher R-values in commercial roofing projects.

Thus far, 12 states have adopted IBC/IECC 2015, resulting in higher minimum R-value requirements. Additional states are considering adoption in 2017, with adoption continuing nationwide throughout the next several years.
